Foundry Family and Friends,

Wow, we're into 2021 and it's almost June, halfway through the year. But this half has certainly been better than the last half of 2020, in terms of the Covid-19 virus and our daily lives. The vaccine is well underway and safety precautions are being minimized. As a church, we're extremely happy and thankful to be back to inperson worship. To keep you informed, our leadership is discussing and planning for the next six months and looking forward into 2022, in regards to certain ministry areas. In particular, we want more folks to be comfortable returning to in-person worship and study classes, we want our music and children's ministries to grow and move forward, and we want to provide adequate support to our video and live-stream worship experiences.

In early 2020, our ministry areas and overall church had seven paid staff on a regular basis, along with several volunteers. During the past year, we have operated with mostly three paid staff and volunteers as needed. But we realize a return to pre-Covid levels, and to provide the additional support needed looking forward, will require continued and increased financial support.
